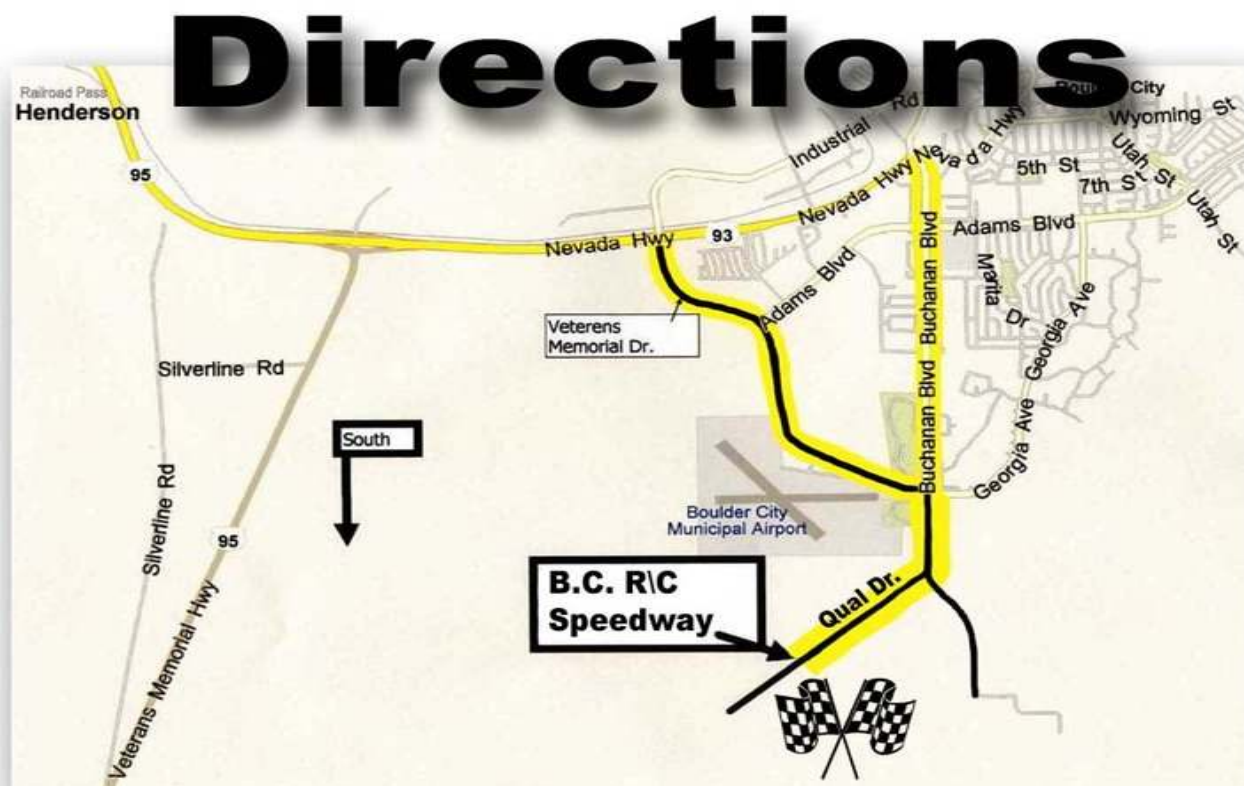

2008 QSACWEST RULES ADDENDUM

- 1) 5 MINUTE RULE FOR ANYONE UNTIL THE RACE STARTS. ONCE GREEN FLAG COMES OUT NO MORE TIME FOR ANYONE, EVEN IF THE RACE HAS TO BE RESTARTED AGAIN. (ONCE PER PERSON)
- 2) THE NUMBER OF CARS IN THE A-MAIN HAS BEEN CHANGED FROM 10 TO 12 CARS/ TRUCKS
- 3) PIT STOPS: CAN BE MADE AT ANYTIME OTHER THAN DURING RED FLAG. WHEN PIT STOP IS MADE UNDER A YELLOW FLAG, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAG THE REAR OF THE FIELD WHEN YOU RETURN TO THE TRACK. THE RACE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR THOSE WORKING ON THEIR CARS.
- 4) OPEN WHEEL CLASS WILL RETAIN THE RULES THAT HAVE BEEN IN USE.

ADDITIONAL CHANGES:

- 1) THE 2008 RACING SEASON WILL HAVE 9 POINTS RACES WITH BEST 6 COUNTING One throw out Per Track unless you attend more than one race at a particular track
- 2) TOP QUALIFIER POINTS AS A TIE BREAKER IF NEEDED
- 3) **NEW 2008 QSAC RULES POSTED PLEASE READ !**

A recent post by one of our Co-chairs Brent Gottfried

Take care about what you read on the forums. There seems to be a lot of kidding that goes on and none of it is to be taken seriously and for a newbie it could be confusing for example:

Nobody is putting tree sap on their tires, in fact adding any treatment to the tire is illegal.

Nobody is running nitrous oxide. Way illegal.

Nobody is running hopped up or oxygenated fuel. A few have tried but the smell usually gives it away. It will, in fact, destroy your engine in short order. Because the possibility exists, all QSAC NCS races are run with specific fuel available only from the track and all tanks are inspected before the cars are allowed to fuel.

Secret or trick parts, QSAC has an Impact Parts Rule. This rule addresses the cost and availability of any new parts in specific areas of the cars that are considered crucial to performance. While some racers will try and test parts of their own design, any part under the Impact rule is subject to QSAC approval and an unapproved part is grounds for disqualification.

Alcohol fuel, in the past QSAC had alcohol classes; they used a much less powerful engine than today's engines. They required a modified carburetor and a tuned pipe in achieve any appreciable power advantage. Current QSAC rule prohibit both alcohol and tuned pipes.

Local tracks are free to modify or change rules (except the safety rules) to suit their individual needs or interests. This does help QSAC grow and adapt. Some tracks adhere to the QSAC rules, this helps the racers when they travel because they know what the rules will be when they arrive. The rules are strictly followed at all National Championship Series (NCS) races.

Please take the time to become familiar with the QSAC rules. They are available to anyone at www.QSAC.org. Should you have a question about something you see posted please ask a more experienced racer or contact a QSAC official.
