QUARTER SCALE NASCAR AND SPRINTCARS FIREBIRD RACEWAY SEPTEMBER 16-18, 2005

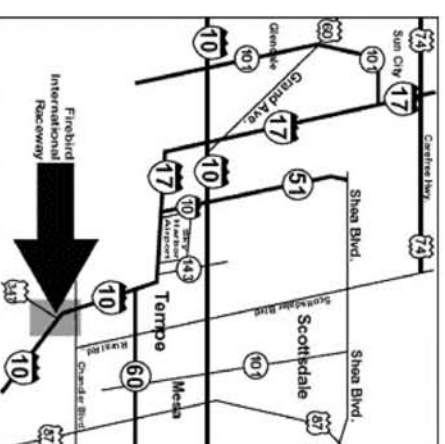
