The last race was in Arizona and had a total of 31 entries. The entries were as follows
3 novice, 7 open wheel, 9 sportsman, 5 truck, 7 GN.

Class winners were, Oscar Smith in Novice, Bob Bates in Open Wheel, Dennis Andrews in Sportsman, Chuck Beeman in Truck, and Steve Mylar in GN.

The weather was great for the weekend with a little wind on Saturday, but lots of good racing anyway. We were also entertained during the weekend with war bird races at the R/C airfield on Saturday and drag racing on Friday and Saturday nights.

As the point season comes to a close, there appears to still battles for the championship in the sportsman, truck, and GN classes. The novice and openwheel classes appear to already have been decided.
