We have had 2 DQs so far 1 for an illegal clutch in sportsman and 1 for being under weight.

The attendance for this year is about the same as last year at this time. Last years first 2 races 1 at Rialto and 1 at Phoenix had 39 entries at each. This year the first race was at Rialto with 37 entries and the 2nd race was in Phoenix with 38 entries.

Speedworld Scale Speedway Whittman, Arizona National Championship Series

May 4-5, 2007

We had a great turnout at the NCS race in Phoenix. We had a record number of entries at the track, getting 46 total racers.

We had eight drivers in the Open Wheel class, and had the cleanest racing I have ever seen in Open Wheel. We ran all eight cars in both Heat races and had some really clean racing. All of the drivers deserve a Big Congrats for their clean driving. Bob Bates, Dave Hart, and Daryl Clay all finished on the lead lap.

There were three cars in Novice and AC lead the whole race until he had linkage failure. Sean Fleek went on to win his first Quarter Scale Race.

Seven Cars took the field in SuperTruck. Jim Dooley and Chuck Beeman swapped the lead several times. Jim squeezed by with a .469 second lead over Chuck.

We had a record of 17 Sportsman cars, and had a chance to run our first C Main. We decided as a group to run 11 cars in the B Main instead. Lance Cote won, with the three other bump ups completing all 100 laps.

The Sportsman Main Event was the only class to see any tech trouble. It was great racing with four cars running all 150 laps. Dennis Andrews led the most laps but ran into some trouble near the end. Brad Toffelmire pulled out the Win, but was later found to have modified Clutch shoes in the motor that he had borrowed. Mike Fleek was awarded the win after finishing in second place.

Finally, the Grand National race was next and again we ran 11 cars. Roger Newell was the TQ and led almost every lap with Tony Evans right on his back bumper. Tony's car had a servo failure with 22 laps remaining while he was making a push to take the lead from Roger.

I think everyone really enjoyed themselves and I had a lot of really positive comments on how well the race was run, RC Scoring Pro and calling lap times over the new PA system. We had racers from 8 states attend, and we appreciate everyone that traveled to be here.

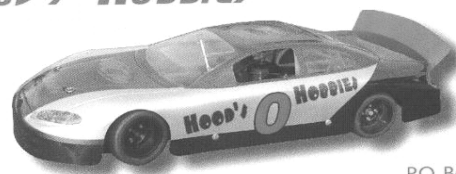

2007 QSAC WEST RULES ADDENDUM:

- 1) 5 MINUTE RULE FOR ANYONE UNTIL THE RACE STARTS. ONCE GREEN FLAG COMES OUT NO MORE TIME FOR ANYONE, EVEN IF THE RACE HAS TO BE RESTARTED AGAIN.(ONCE PER PERSON)
- 2) THE NUMBER OF CARS IN THE A-MAIN HAS BEEN CHANGED FROM 10 TO 12 CARS/ TRUCKS.
- 3) ALL SPORTSMAN AND NOVICE CARS WILL BE REQUIRED TO RUN AN 8.5MM RESTRICTOR. NO MATTER WHICH QSAC LEGAL CARB. YOU USE.
- 4) PIT STOPS: CAN BE MADE AT ANYTIME OTHER THAN DURING RED FLAG. WHEN PIT STOP IS MADE UNDER A YELLOW FLAG, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAG THE REAR OF THE FIELD WHEN YOU RETURN TO THE TRACK. THE RACE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR THOSE WORKING ON THEIR CARS.
- 5) OPENWHEEL CLASS WILL RETAIN THE RULES THAT HAVE BEEN IN USE.

ADDITIONAL CHANGES:

- 1) THE 2007 RACING SEASON WILL HAVE 6 POINTS RACES WITH ALL RACES COUNTING.
NO THROWOUTS
- 2) THERE WILL NOT BE A MONEY PAYOUT AT SEASON END. HOWEVER THERE WILL BE TROPHIES/PLAQUES.
