### 2008 QSAC West Points Series

The QSAC West Board wants to welcome the QSAC West family to another great year of racing. In adhering to the wishes of the QSAC West membership, we have implemented some format changes to our race schedule. This should give more racers the opportunity to fit quarterscale racing into their busy lives and allow them to be in the running for the point's championship until the end of the season.

We also have 3 one-day races scheduled as night races in the summer. One at each track.

The format for all races are posted at <http://www.qsacwest.com>

The issue of green or red pit stops: We will vote at each track as to which format we will be using. A vote will be taken during the drivers meeting.

At the first race at Milestone, we will be using last years' QSAC West approved restrictor plates. These plates will be subject to post-race inspection and must comply with the 2008, QSAC specifications. Please bring your plate to a tech inspector for verification. This will also apply to the new plates. There has been a delay in the release of the "NEW" QSAC restrictor/adaptor plates. These plates will be mandatory at our March race at Speed World and or course, all NCS races. The board decided on this delay to allow adequate time for the membership to attain these new plates. I encourage everyone to order their plates. <http://www.willmannracingproducts.com> The manufacturer's and parts suppliers will also have a supply of these plates. Larry at Quarterscalemotorsports; Bob Leydecker at Bob's Motor Sports; Bob Bates at Bull's Eye. QSAC membership is required to participate in any QSAC or QSAC West event. This applies to mechanics and drivers and anyone in the drivers, track, and/or "hot pit" area.

If you have not received your membership renewal, there will be membership applications available at the track. This is mandatory!

Milestone Ranch: I would like to thank Larry of Quarterscalemotorsports for a number of great improvements at the Milestone Ranch facility. The 40' x 9 1/2' tall drivers stand really adds to the drivers visibility, also, I am quite sure that the addition of the new, soft-wall technology will save all us a lot of money on parts and repairs. **2008 QSACWEST RULES ADDENDUM**

- 1) 5 MINUTE RULE FOR ANYONE UNTIL THE RACE STARTS. ONCE GREEN FLAG COMES OUT NO MORE TIME FOR ANYONE, EVEN IF THE RACE HAS TO BE RESTARTED AGAIN. (ONCE PER PERSON)
- 2) THE NUMBER OF CARS IN THE A-MAIN HAS BEEN CHANGED FROM 10 TO 12 CARS/ TRUCKS
- 3) ALL CARS WILL BE REQUIRED TO RUN A RESTRICTOR PLATE 8.5 FOR SPORTSMAN / NOV-ICE , 10.5 FOR ALL OTHERS NO MATTER WHICH QSAC LEGAL CARB. YOU USE.
- 4) PIT STOPS: CAN BE MADE AT ANYTIME OTHER THAN DURING RED FLAG. WHEN PIT STOP IS MADE UNDER A YELLOW FLAG, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAG THE REAR OF THE FIELD WHEN YOU RETURN TO THE TRACK. THE RACE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR THOSE WORKING ON THEIR CARS.
- 5) OPEN WHEEL CLASS WILL RETAIN THE RULES THAT HAVE BEEN IN USE.

**ADDITIONAL CHANGES:**

- 1) THE 2008 RACING SEASON WILL HAVE 9 POINTS RACES WITH BEST 6 COUNTING One throughout Per Track unless you attend more than one race at a particular track
- 2) TOP QUALIFIER POINTS AS A TIE BREAKER IF NEEDED
- 3) **NEW 2008 QSAC RULES POSTED PLEASE READ !**

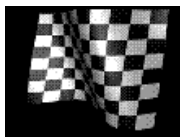

Preparations are well underway for the first 2008 QSAC WEST Regional Series race. You will not recognize the track since your last visit. We have a new drivers stand for better driver perception (especially for us older guys). The safer barrier will surround the entire perimeter of the track with lots of run off room in the corners. The new track layout will save a lot of wrecked cars. It was tested last Saturday by several cars and did its job.

Limited power is available so generators are recommended. We will broadcast the event on FM so a radio in your pit will be a great help.

Asphalt grindings cover about half of the pit areas and more is on the way to complete the entire parking lot.

The oval will be the same size as we ran last year. Other configurations are available for future races.

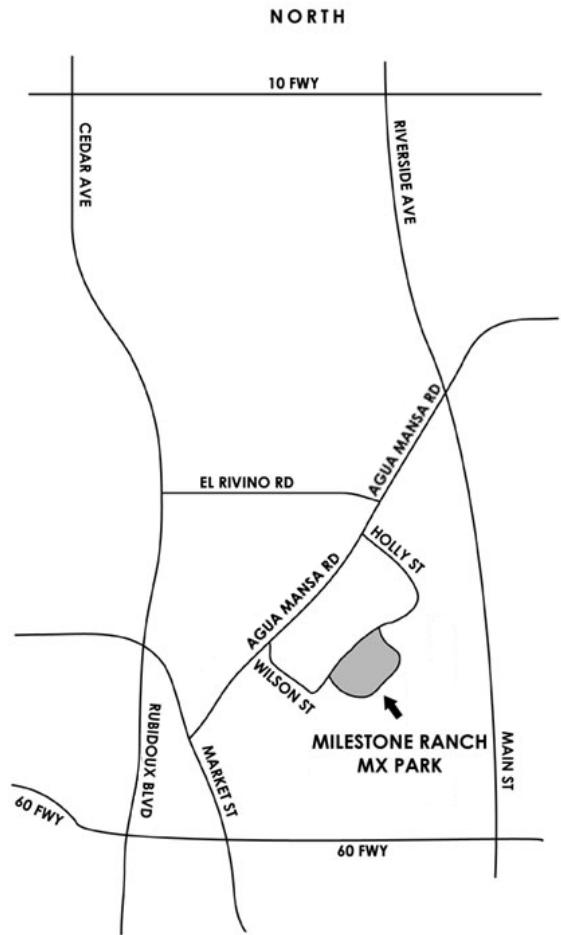
Motor home and camper parking will be available for \$35 for the weekend or \$20 per night payable at the entry gate. There are no hook ups available. Park gates open at 8:00AM and gates close at 9:30PM. No entry or exit after gates close.

Each driver will pay \$10 at the gate each day and \$20 for class entry at track sign up. For Friday arrivals there is no additional entry fee.

Spectators and pit help are admitted to the park for no charge. When there is a motocross race every person including spectators pays \$10 admission at the gate. Check "milestonemx.com for those dates.

We have many upgrades in the works. More lighting for summer night racing will be installed soon.
